Indoor Air Quality

West Central Area School District advocates a healthy school environment in which the surroundings contribute to an environment conducive to learning for students, and productivity for teachers and staff. To help accomplish this, we have implemented an IAQ Management Plan using guidelines provided by the Minnesota Department of Education, and the "Tools for Schools" document developed by the U.S. EPA. Asbestos Notification

In accordance with federal regulations, West Central Area School District has management plans documenting the location and condition of all known or assumed asbestos containing materials (ACM) in each of the West Central Area School District buildings. Every six months, an accredited inspector visually inspects the condition of the ACM. The management plans are available for public inspection at the respective buildings during normal business hours. Mr. Norenberg, Buildings and Grounds Director is the Designated Person, responsible for maintaining the asbestos management plans for all West Central Area School District locations. Pesticide Notice

A state law went into effect in the two thousand that requires schools to inform parents and guardians if they apply certain pesticides on school property. Lead in Water Notification

Minnesota Statute 121A.335 requires public school buildings serving pre-kindergarten through grade 12 to test for lead in water every five (5) years.
